1 **Q. PLEASE STATE YOUR NAME, BUSINESS ADDRESS AND TITLE.**

2 A. My name is Byron Crawford. I am a Principal at Longview Solar, LLC, a Joint Venture
3 of TUUSSO Energy and IW Holdings Corporation (a US affiliate of a Canada-based
4 renewable independent power producer, Elemental Energy). Our office is located at 1080
5 W. Ewing Pl - Suite B10, Seattle, WA 98119.

6 **Q. PLEASE DESCRIBE YOUR QUALIFICATIONS.**

7 A. Seven years ago, I co-founded TUUSSO Energy LLC, which develops utility-scale solar
8 photovoltaic power plants across the United States. I have earned a BA from Rutgers
9 University, an MA in Labor in Industrial Relations from Rutgers School of Management,
10 and an MBA from the University of Chicago.

11 **Q. HAVE YOU PREVIOUSLY TESTIFIED BEFORE THIS COMMISSION?**

12 A. Yes. I testified on behalf of LS-Egret, LLC for a CPCN to construct a 15 MW solar
13 photovoltaic project in Wicomico County (Case 9366).

14 **Q. ARE YOU FAMILIAR WITH LONGVIEW SOLAR, LLC'S LS-HERON SOLAR
15 FARM PROJECT IN WORCESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND?**

16 A. Yes, I am involved in all aspects of the development of the LS-Heron Solar Farm Project
17 (the "Project").

18 **Q. WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF YOUR TESTIMONY IN THIS PROCEEDING?**

19 A. To introduce the Longview Solar, LLC and to sponsor Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4A-B of
20 Longview's Environmental Review Document (Longview Solar Exhibit ____ (BC-2)).

21 **Q. DID YOU PREPARE THESE SECTIONS OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW
22 DOCUMENT, OR WERE THEY PREPARED UNDER YOUR SUPERVISION?**

1 A. Yes.

2 **Q. ARE THERE ANY ADDITIONS OR CHANGES TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL**
3 **REVIEW DOCUMENT NOW BEING SUBMITTED AS AN EXHIBIT TO YOUR**
4 **TESTIMONY SINCE IT WAS ORIGINALLY FILED AS PART OF LONGVIEW**
5 **SOLAR'S APPLICATION IN THIS PROCEEDING?**

7 **Q. ARE THERE ANY OTHER CHANGES OR ADDITIONS AT THIS TIME?**

8 A. None at this time.

9 **Q. PLEASE EXPLAIN FOR THE RECORD WHY THE TIMELY ISSUANCE OF A**
10 **FINAL CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY IS**
11 **ESSENTIAL FOR THE PROJECT.**

12 A. Longview Solar, LLC must obtain revenue from the sale of the Renewable Energy
13 Credits from the project in order to secure financing with a targeted date to begin
14 receiving such revenue in Fall/Winter of 2016. As a result, any delays in the project that
15 extend the start of construction and operation may compromise the financing for the
16 project. It is our goal to align project construction and interconnection to receive all
17 necessary local and state approvals and engineering documents by spring of 2016 so that
18 the project can begin operation by fall/winter 2016. We hope to begin construction by
19 late-spring or early-summer of 2016.

20 **Q. WHEN MUST THE FINAL CPCN BE ISSUED TO ALLOW CONSTRUCTION**
21 **TO BEGIN LATE-SPRING/EARLY-SUMMER 2016?**

1 A. Longview Solar, LLC is committed to meeting the operation target of Fall/Winter 2016
2 and we estimate that a May 11, 2016 issuance is necessary to allow for sufficient time to
3 allow construction to begin in the late-Spring or early-Summer of 2016.
